**Addendum No. 1**  
**Date of Addendum: March 1, 2018**

**The purpose of this Addendum is to provide additional information related to this project and to address submitted questions. This addendum shall be considered part of the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents and is issued to change, amplify, or delete from or otherwise explain these documents where provisions of this addendum differ from those of the original documents. This addendum shall have precedence over the original documents and shall govern. Bids are due March 9, 2018 by 10:00 A.M.**

1. Does the average count of (12) pulls per month include the hauls of Christmas trees in December and January?
  - The average of 12 individual pulls per month includes Christmas trees in 2017.
2. If not, what is the average number of hauls for the Christmas trees?
  - See #1.
3. What is the average weight per haul for the 30 yard recycle roll-offs?
  - Approximately .8 tons.
4. What is the average weight per haul for the 20 yard recycle roll-off?
  - Approximately .8 tons.
5. Current pricing:

6. What is the current rate per haul per container size, delivery charge(s) and price per yard of compost the Town of Superior is paying its current vendor?
  - See #5.
7. Are any of the roll-offs kept on site year round?
  - Yes, all are on site and site operation is year round.
8. If not, what is the delivery schedule for the 30 yard roll-offs and how many deliveries for recycling containers would be required annually?
  - See above.
9. Does the Town of Superior consider the use of yard waste as alternate daily cover (ACD) at a landfill as recycling? Some companies who offer construction recycling services for wood waste, drywall and yard waste are delivering these materials to landfills for use as ACD. Woody yard waste generated in Boulder County is also under quarantine for the Emerald Ash Borer. If the woody waste is not taken to Front Range Landfill in Erie or the Foothills landfill in Golden, it must be processed to pass a 1" x1" screen from April through November to meet state quarantine requirements before it can be transported out of Boulder County. Would it be prudent for the Town of Superior to require bidders to disclose the name and location of the facility the Town's materials will be delivered to for processing to insure they are being recycled and meet state quarantine requirements?
  - The Town is looking to hire a vendor who handles this process legally and professionally.
10. The word "waste" is mentioned multiple times in the bid yet everything listed as service is organics material.

- The site is a Yard Waste site and typically all matter is organic material. However, at times containers may be contaminated with non-organic material. The vendor must have a plan should this occur.
- a. I just want to be sure that this is 100% for organics/yard waste
    - See #10.
  11. The bid states that the town wants to have the finished compost product delivered back to them, do you have an area on site where the material would be dumped? We would have to offload the compost on site so we could utilize the roll offs.
    - Typically, one 30 yard container filled with compost is deposited into a compost bay at the yard waste facility as requested by the Town for resident use. The empty container is then utilized at the site for yard waste.
  12. Will the debris placed in the roll off containers be compacted in any way?
    - Town staff may attempt to compact materials so as not to exceed the height of container walls.
  13. What will the response time be, once requested, for the weekends?
    - The response time shall be prior to opening next day both during the week and weekends.
  14. All pricing for service must be included in the bid schedule rates
