Agenda Items:

1. Committee Leadership Elections - The Committee held leadership elections. The following members were elected: Committee Chair – Jack Adams, Committee Vice Chairs – Allie Reuter and Rachel Williams, Committee Secretary, Alik Christianian, Committee Treasurer, Grace Batey.
2. Discussion – New Committee Name/Logo. The Committee discussed changing its name from the Youth Services Committee. After several ideas were discussed the Committee would like to recommend the name change to the Superior Youth Leadership Council. The Committee also discussed coming up with a logo, the group is going to work on coming up with a few logo-ideas before the January meeting where they will bring them for everyone to vote one.
3. Discussion - 2015 Work Plan. The Committee continued to discuss plans for their 2015 Work Plan. The Committee discussed several ideas to present to the Board such as hosting a Parents Night Out, volunteering with the senior population at Balfour, an animal adoption event in conjunction with another Town event, community kickball tournament on July 4, creating a float for the Fourth of July parade, increasing activities at the 2015 Arbor Day Celebration, working on partnerships with the Youth Advisory Committee in Louisville and possibly Lafayette, working with local elementary schools, working with Louisville Public Library to create a reading in the park program, and contacting local restaurants for fundraising opportunities. The 2015 Work Plan will be finalized at the January meeting for Board approval.
4. Discussion – Count the Lights Holiday Event. The Committee will work with the Historical Commission and Town Staff to host the Count the Lights Holiday Event on December 6 at Asti Park. Several members of the Committee met on Saturday, November 22 to string lights on the historic fire truck. Members of the YSC signed up for various jobs throughout the night such as serving s'mores, serving drinks, and the guess the lights station. All Committee members who are able to attend will meet at 4:00 pm to start set up of the event.
