Agenda Items:

1. Debriefing – December and early January.
  - a. Visits to the Museum during the January opening were low.
  - b. Staff updated the group as to the names of the top three area youth who submitted winning guesses for the Count the Lights on the fire truck program.
2. Discussion – Cataloging/Filing Update. Members of the Committee met at the Museum on January 9 and re-initiated the lengthy process of cataloging and filing donations to the Museum.
3. Discussion – Museum Window Shades. On January 5 a contractor through JC Penney completed installation of eight new window shades in the Museum.
4. Discussion – Bednar & Bonelli Family Memorial Swing Bench. Town Staff recently completed installation of the Bednar & Bonelli family memorial swing-bench and plaque in Asti Park.
5. Discussion – Spring Education Program. Larry Dorsey will present on historic railroads in Boulder County on April 23, 2015 at Town Hall.
6. Discussion – Fire Truck Restoration. Town Staff along with Gladys Forshee met with representatives of Mile High Classics on January 14 at Guardian Storage and discussed restoration of the Town’s historic fire truck. Mile High Classics will provide the Town with a written quote for rebuilding the truck’s engine and braking system. In addition to this, Errol Waligorski will be initiating discussions with the service manager from Mountain Truck & Equipment Company, who had previously shown an interest in looking at the truck and potentially providing a quote for restoration.
7. Discussion – Joint Meeting with Town Board. The Commission’s annual joint meeting with the Town Board will be held at Town Hall on April 13 at 5:30 p.m.
8. Discussion – Museum Furnace. Staff informed the Commission that the Museum’s HVAC unit has been added to the Town’s regular preventative maintenance schedule with Highlands Heating and Air.
