Agenda Items:

1. New Business and Updates

- a. Household Hazardous Waste and Hard to Recycle Collection Event (April 18, 9:00 am to noon, Eldorado K-8) – staff continues to work through event logistics with Eco-Cycle and Boulder County staff. Committee volunteers confirmed to help staff the event along with Town administrative staff: Laura and Anne from 8:30 to 10:30; and Kimberly and Tanya from 10:30 to 12:30.
- b. Arbor Day (April 18, 10:00 am to noon, Founders Park) – the event will include presenters on landscape and sustainability-related topics, along with tree-planting and other activities. The Committee will have a presence at a table with hand-outs to distribute again this year. Rachael plans to staff the table.
- c. Boulder County Environmental Sustainability Grant – staff submitted last month an application requesting funding to help replace waste-only receptacles at Town park facilities with waste stations that include a separate recycling container. The grant was approved for \$15,000.
- d. Advisory Committee Open House (April 16, 6:00 pm at Town Hall) – calendar note.
- e. Bulk item waste pick-up alternatives – posted in the April Town newsletter and website is a list of alternatives for residents to discard unwanted items, including several to help avoid landfilling these items.
- f. Compost pick-up service – coordinated promotion with Rock Creek Master Homeowners Association – the vendor has confirmed price and schedule for this year for both the Town and RCHOA, and staff will print flyers to distribute at the Arbor Day event.
