Roll Call

- 1. Review and Discussion - Arbor Day, April 18.** Staff reviewed the Arbor Day Celebration volunteer assignments and information for the event. The event volunteer slots will be split into two shifts, 9:30am – 11am and 11:00am-12:30pm. The first shift will arrive 30-minutes prior to the event for set-up and the second will stay 30-minutes following the event for tear-down. Council members will oversee craft tables and the Youth Leadership Council informational table where introductory flyers will be distributed.

- 2. Review and Discussion - National Trails Day.** Council members provided input on rules for “Predator and Prey”, which the group will be hosting as an activity during National Trails Day on June 7 from 9am-12pm. Participants will be provided props to indicate their role in the game and Council members will participate as guides to facilitate the activity. Volunteer sign-up for this event will occur during the May 6 meeting.

- 3. Review and Discussion - Park Reading Program.** The Council planned the following logistical items for the Park Reading Program:
 - The proposed name of the reading program is “Purple Park Party Pages”
 - The program will occur on the 2nd Wednesday and 4th Saturday of the month for one hour beginning Saturday, May 30 through Wednesday, August 12
 - Each program will have a story, games, and participant costumes that all coincide with a theme. The Council plans to designate themes during their next regular meeting on May 6
 - The target audience will be age 10-years and younger
 - Possible readers could be community leaders (Mayor, Trustees, Sheriff Deputies, and Firefighters), local teachers, library staff from the Louisville Public Library, and volunteer community members.
 - Staff will reach out to the Superior Elementary Summer Reading Program to discuss a potential partnership and work to establish a partnership with Whole Foods for a possible cookie-reward program.

4. Review and Discussion - 4th of July. The Council recommends opening kickball registration on June 1. Discussion for this item will be continued at the May 6 meeting.
