Call Meeting to Order

Roll Call

- 1. Review and Discussion - National Trails Day Activity**– The “Predator and Prey” activity rules were reviewed and set for the event. The Council notified staff of props needed for the activity and a volunteer sign-up was sent via email to Council members.
- 2. Review and Discussion - Park Reading Program** – The Council planned the following logistical items for the Park Reading Program:
  - a. To ensure program inclusivity, the group relocated the program to Community Park for its central location in the Town
  - b. The new name of the program will be Community Park Story time
  - c. The program will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday, June through August, from 10-11am
  - d. Program dates and themes are as follows:
    - June 10<sup>th</sup>, Community Heroes
    - June 24<sup>th</sup>, Red, White, and Boom
    - July 8<sup>th</sup>, Superheroes
    - July 22<sup>nd</sup>, Fairytales and Magic
    - August 5<sup>th</sup>, A Day at the Zoo
    - August 19<sup>th</sup>, PJ Party
  - e. An invitation for Guest Readers was drafted and will be sent to the Sheriff’s office, fire department, Trustees, teachers, librarians, and local parents by the end of May.
- 3. Review and Discussion - Kickball Tournament** – The Council developed the following plans for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Kickball tournament:
  - a. The kickball tournament will occur on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 6-10pm, with the championship game occurring on 4<sup>th</sup> of July at 11am. Games will be held on Stewart Field at Community Park.

- b. The Family League team roster must consist 40% of players who are between the ages of 8 – 14. Games will be 3 innings or 30 minutes long.
  - c. There will be a Competitive league that does not have an age restriction. Games will be 5 innings or 50 minutes long.
  - d. At least 4 Council members will be staffing the tournament for registration, score keeping, and timing
  - e. Games will be self-policed – no umpires
  - f. Prizes for Family League will be 4<sup>th</sup> of July Event T-Shirts and ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Competitive League will compete for a 1<sup>st</sup> place trophy.
  - g. Registration will begin on June 1<sup>st</sup> and end on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 4. Review and Discussion – 4<sup>th</sup> of July -** Council members can choose between staffing the Kickball Tournament, working the 4<sup>th</sup> of July event as a Volunteer Lead, or working as part the sub-committee that will develop logistics for the group's parade float.
