

**Town of Superior**  
**Historical Commission Meeting**  
**Notes**  
**July 17, 2015**

Agenda Items:

1. Debriefing – June and early July.
  - a. New Historical Commission member Katie Olson was introduced to the group.
  - b. Bob Morgan reported a current balance of \$1490.20 in the HISTORICAL COMMISSION account (10-250-500) and \$983.00 in the HISTORIC FIRE TRUCK account (10-250-501). Staff informed the group that these funds would be used to cover the cost of Mountain Truck and Equipment Company's recent work to make the historic fire truck operable.
  - c. Commission members enjoyed seeing the historic fire truck driven in the July 4<sup>th</sup> Parade. In the future, Commission Chair Larry Dorsey remarked that he thinks it may be a good idea to relocate the Commission's booth back inside the park for the Pancake Breakfast. This year's Commission tent was set-up outside of the park entrance, next to the historic fire truck, and Larry said that many people attending did not seem to notice the group's display.
  - d. Toward the end of the Pancake Breakfast the historic fire truck was relocated and displayed in front of the Museum. July's Museum opening saw around eight visitors.
2. Discussion – Cataloging/Filing Update. The group set a date of July 24 for their next session of cataloging and filing of donated items.
3. Discussion – Superior's Wikipedia Information. Maureen Hogg provided an update to the group regarding her research into obtaining more information on the Town's founding and incorporated dates and revising them if necessary on the Wikipedia site for Superior, Colorado. Maureen recently visited the Norlin Library and found that they have two maps, one from the past when Superior was a township and one after the Town was platted. The group is excited to see what information is listed on the earlier map.
4. Discussion – Fire Truck Restoration. Commission member Errol Waligorski will contact Bob Gissel of Mountain Truck & Equipment Co. to get more information on costs associated with body work restoration of the truck. A general estimate for this work would be beneficial as Town staff is currently working to finalize budget requests to the Board for funding in the 2016 Budget.

5. Discussion – Museum Maintenance. Staff has received three estimates from paint contractors to re-paint the Museum building – Vivax Pro & Painting Co., Green Sage Painting, and Five Star Painting. Pending a review of the contractor's past work and company testimonials, members of the Commission passed a motion to proceed with Green Sage Painting and have this work completed.
6. Discussion – Louise Bennett House. Staff informed the group that the house owned by Louise Bennett at 122 Coal Creek Drive has been acquired by an individual, not the Town, and this person is currently trying to secure a water tap.
7. Discussion – Summer Potluck. Karen and Errol Waligorski will be hosting a potluck event at their house on August 16 at 4 pm.
8. Discussion – Asti Park Volunteer Project. The Asti Park Fix-Up Volunteer Project has been re-scheduled for September 19, which will be this year's National Day of Service for the Town.
9. Discussion – Grasso Park Barn Environmental Clean-up. Staff is working to schedule a date with RITECorp, a Colorado pest control service company, to perform an environmental clean-up of the barn in Grasso Park.
