New Business

- 1. Review Work Plan** – The Council reviewed the 2015-2016 Work Plan and passed a motion:
 - a. The Council unanimously recommends for the Board’s review of the 2015-2016 Work Plan (attached).*
- 2. Review Resolution 37**– The Council revisited the attendance policy and term limit changes listed in Resolution 37 approved by the Town Board. Beginning this term, Council members will be expected to notify the staff liaison twenty-four hours prior to a meeting absence, except in cases of emergency. Upon two consecutive meeting absences, or four absences in one-year, the Council will recommend the Member be removed by the Board of Trustees. Term limits have also been extended to two years beginning September 1 and ending August 31 two years later, unless they are in their senior year, in which it is a one-year term.
- 3. Treats for Troops – Community Project** – The Council will be emailing Superior Elementary, Monarch K-8, and Eldorado K-8 to host drop-off boxes for donations of Halloween candy, unopened tooth brushes, toothpaste, floss, and letters for the troops. Members will also submit an announcement to be made at the high schools encouraging peers to go trick-or-treating on Halloween for Treats for Troops. Marketing will begin after receiving confirmation from the local schools that will host a donation drop-off. Candy sorting will occur at the November 4 meeting.
- 4. GoCo Grant Support Letter** – The Council wrote a letter in support of the GoCo Grant Application for the proposed 12 acre park located next to

Eldorado K-8. The Council supports the project as it provides increased accessibility to parks and open space for local kids, especially those living south of Coalton Road. As former students, the Council endorses a project which would create a welcoming environment for students walking to school and would create space for children, teens, and families to enjoy the great outdoors.

- 5. Review and Discussion - Count the Lights** - The Council will host a canned food drive and Toys for Tots campaign in conjunction with the Count the Lights event on December 5. The event will be a kick-off to a two week Toys-for-Tots campaign to collect donations. At the event there will be a give-away of a Tutti-Fruiti and Chick-fil-A gift card to incentivize donations. Council members will help distribute food and drinks throughout the event in addition to running the donation drop-off booth.

- 1. Board Presentation of Work Plan** – Members Allie Reuter, Kassen Qian, Grace Batey, Rachel Williams, and Connor Reuter will attend the Board meeting on October 26th to present the 2015-2016 Superior Youth Leadership Council Work Plan to the Board of Trustees.
- 2. Council Leadership Voting** – The Council will elect a leadership team consisting of a Council Chair, Co-Chair, and Secretary each year. Interested candidates should notify staff, on or before November 4. The Council will nominate and elect leadership positions for the 2015-2016 term at the November 4 meeting.
