Agenda Items:

1. Public Comment

- a. Jim Paine updated with the Committee regarding the RCMHOA's ongoing efforts to research methods to deal with windy conditions on trash/recycling pick-up days, and coordinating email reminders from the RCMHOA and Town with specific guidelines – but with Monday pick-up days this is difficult to coordinate on Sundays.

2. New Business and Updates

- a. Event Recap – Fall Document Shredding and Electronics Recycling Event with Guardian Storage (October 26 – November 13) – the Town partnered with Guardian Storage to host this event, and they received 6,039 pounds of paper and 3,234 pounds of electronic waste – both amounts increased from last year.
- b. Annual Christmas Tree Program with Scouts – staff is coordinating this year's program with Boy Scout Troops 278 and 575 on January 9.
- c. Household Hazardous Waste and Hard to Recycle Collection Event (April 16, 9:00 am to noon, Eldorado K-8) – calendar note.
- d. Newsletter and website information – this month's newsletter included the bulk item disposal options, indoor water audits, Christmas tree pick-up program, EnergySmart program tips, and eco-holiday shopping information.

3. Discussion – Boulder County PACE Program – Superior Business Community Engagement. Lea Yancey of the Boulder County Sustainability Office plans to attend next month's meeting, when she will update the Committee on the recently hired business advisor's outreach to businesses here, Louisville and Lafayette, and share the program's recently assembled toolkit of ideas for municipalities to use for business recognition.

4. Discussion – 2016 Work Plan. The Committee discussed items to potentially be considered for next year’s Work Plan, and will plan to review during next month’s meeting.
