INSTRUCTIONS

This Notice **MUST** be provided to the eligible electors of the District between November 16, 2015 and January 15, 2016. The Notice must be provided in **AT LEAST ONE** of the following manners:

- a) Post the Notice on District's official website **and** provide the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) (<http://www.colorado.gov/dola>) with the address of the District's website so that DOLA may provide a link. Districts may use DOLA's Contact Update form available on its website or by request; OR,
- b) Post the Notice on the Special District Association's (SDA) website (<http://www.sdaco.org>) (**Note:** The District must be an SDA member to post on the SDA's website. Notices may be sent to the SDA by mail or electronic transmission); OR,
- c) Include the Notice as a prominent part of a newsletter, annual report, billing insert, billing statement, letter, voter information card, or other notice of election, or other informational mailing sent by the District to the eligible electors; OR,
- d) Mail the Notice separately to each household where one or more eligible electors of the District resides (**Note:** Districts with overlapping boundaries may combine mailed Notices, so long as the information regarding each District is separately displayed and identified); OR,
- e) For a District with less than one thousand eligible electors that is wholly located within a county with a population of less than thirty thousand, post the Notice in at least three public places within the boundaries of the District and, in addition, post a copy of the Notice in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of the county in which the District is located. Such Notices must remain posted until the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of the following May.

Additionally, a copy of this Notice **MUST** be filed with:

- Clerk and Recorder of each county in which the District is located
- Assessor of each county in which the District is located
- Treasurer of each county in which the District is located
- Board of County Commissioners of each county in which the District is located
