New Business

- 1. Make It A Superior 2016** – The Council will hold their New Years’ Resolution program at the Rocky Mountain Fire Station on January 26 from 7-8pm, open to all ages. The group will facilitate workshops about developing Specific Measureable Achievable Realist and Time-bound goals, apps to help maintain goals, and “Breaking Barriers,” a workshop about pushing past restraints to achieve goals. Between each workshop the Council will present the following TEDTalks as anecdotes to their workshops: “Keep Your Goals to Yourself” and “Try Something New for 30 Days.” Marketing will be done through creating a Facebook event, CAC’s and E-blasts. Each member will also bring at least one peer, friend, or family member to increase attendance.
- 2. Parent’s Night Out** – After reviewing the logistics of the Parent’s Night Out program the Council decided to post-pone the program until the fall. The pool party program identified in the 2015-2016 Work Plan will serve as an exploratory experience before taking on Parent’s Night Out this spring.
- 3. Cyber Senior Event** – The Council will host a “Cyber Senior Event” at the end of February at Sunrise Senior Living in Broomfield, date and time to be determined upon approval from the facility. The Council will help local seniors with technical questions including iPhone use, email, and Facebook. The program will be an Open House in which a senior will be paired with a Council member for one-on-one attention with their personal devices.
- 4. Town Flag** – The Council worked to design four flag concepts for the Board of Trustees review on the meeting of January 11. See flag concepts below.

5. **MLK Day of Service** – On January 18, 2016, The Council will be participating in the MLK March for Peace and Celebration at the Festival Plaza in Lafayette from 12 – 3 pm.
