1. Meeting called to order (6:30 p.m.)
2. Updates and Lookahead:
 - Coyote Hike Recap. Wildlife ecologist Ashley DeLaup received positive feedback for being very personable and for the wealth of information she provided during the program. There were seventeen participants.
 - Coal Creek Corridor. The Town Board is waiting for additional information from the Town attorney on project funding. OSAC members would like to meet with PROS staff to review a copy of the PD for Parcels 1 and 2 in the Superior Town Center.
 - US 36/Davidson Mesa Underpass. No new information.
 - Superior Town Center – naturalized buffer area. The developer has agreed to restore the buffer to the original grade and the Town Board recommends a public process.
 - Winter Wildlife Walk – Calendar note: February 20th from 9-11 am South Pool Parking Lot.
3. Discussion – Recap of Joint Town Board Meeting and follow-up items.
 - OSAC Mission and Goals are updated on the Town website.
 - OSAC plans to make a recommendation regarding a RFP process for expedited trail construction at the next regular meeting.
 - OSAC is interested in working on a volunteer trail restoration program and would like to potentially collaborate with SYLC, Boulder County Youth Corps and the Town's Volunteer Program Specialist.
 - The group discussed including potential trails that are funded from private and public sources other than open space sources on the OSAC trails map.
