New Business

1. **Make It A Superior 2016 Debrief** – The Council discussed the January program and the overall consensus of the program was that it was successfully executed but they would not like to continue the program in the future due to low attendance.
2. **Cyber Senior Event** – The Council members have reviewed the informational packet “How to be a Cyber Seniors Facilitator” and will be conducting mock information sessions at the March 2 meeting. The program will be on March 12 from 2-4pm at the Louisville Senior Center.
3. **Town Flag** – The Council listened to the January 11 Board of Trustees meeting to review comments and suggestions regarding the Town Flag designs. The Council will be searching for potential fonts for the “The Gateway to Boulder Valley” of the flag design, and also suggested adding a charcoal gray portion to the flag with the wave. A new design will be reviewed at the March 2 meeting.
4. **Arbor Day Art Contest** – The Council determined this year’s Arbor Day Art Contest to be themed, “The Great Outdoors” with submissions of paintings, photographs, or digital art pieces being accepted beginning March 1. Age categories will remain the same, K-3rd grade, 4-8th grade, 9-12th grade, 18 years of age and older with the addition of a Pre-K category. The artwork will be brought to the Arbor Day event by the contestants where it will be judged by the Council. First, Second, and Third place will receive a prize based on age group. Pre-K and K-3rd grade will receive a coloring book with colored pencils and 4-8th grade, 9-12th grade, 18 years of age and older will receive a Starbucks gift card.
