**New Business**

1. **Cyber Senior Open-House** – The Council discussed the March 12 Cyber Senior program and reviewed potential questions that participants may ask about mobile devices, email, or social media. Council members will be at the Louisville Recreation Center from 2-4pm in the Brooks 1 room wearing their Council shirts.
2. **Arbor Day (April 16)** – The Council reviewed the voting process for the Arbor Day Art Contest and planned to use painting and drawing as their craft to increase day-of submissions. There will also be a craft table where participants can draw leaves. The leaves will be added to a large poster of a tree.
3. **National Trails Day (June 5)** – The Council brainstormed potential crafts or activities for National Trails Day. Potential ideas were creating bird feeders, hosting a shoe drive, giving out bird whistles or holding a water balloon fight. After the water balloon fight, the Council will provide an education piece about the Leave No Trace program while participants clean up the water balloon pieces.
4. **Community Park Storytime** – The Council will be hosting Community Park Storytime again this year on June 8, July 13, and August 10 for one hour beginning at 10 am at Community Park. They will invite guest readers including local firefighters, police officers, Town Board members, and teachers to participate. The Council will hand out snacks and raffle off books at each reading.
5. **4<sup>th</sup> of July Kickball Tournament** – The Council will be hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Kickball Family Tournament on Sunday, July 3. It will be a non-competitive tournament for family teams that have a ratio of one child to every three adults. Following the championship game of tournament, there will be a competitive pick-up game. On July 4 there will be a pick-up

family game coinciding with the Pancake Breakfast. Marketing will be done through Facebook, E-Blasts, and yard signs. More details will be discussed at the April 6 meeting.

6. **School's Out Pool Party** – On June 10, the Council will be hosting a pool party from 6-8 pm for local residents ages 8-13 at North Pool. The Council would like to show a movie in the pool and offset the costs by seeking sponsorship from the HOA or other local businesses. Advertising will be done via Facebook and the local schools before school ends.
7. **Town Flag** –The Council reviewed the new flag designs with fonts submitted by Council members as well as the addition of the charcoal gray. The Council preferred the font from the flag #1 and would like flag #1 in the inverse colors (Burgundy flag, charcoal wave). The flag changes will be submitted to the Town Board for review.
