

**Town of Superior  
Historical Commission Meeting  
Notes  
November 21, 2014**

Agenda Items:

1. Debriefing – October and early November.
  - a. Danny Kupfner was among 3 visitors to the Museum opening on November 1.
  - b. Members of the Commission would like to formally thank the Town for hosting the Volunteer Appreciation Dinner at the Renaissance Hotel in Broomfield on November 13.
  - c. Staff provided to the group an update and list of repair items that were completed by Wattle & Daub Contractors to the structures in Grasso Park on November 18 - over 400 pounds of dirt and debris was removed from the main house attic. The group discussed the larger scale capital improvement work that is expected to be performed at Grasso Park and the Museum in 2015.
2. Discussion – Count the Lights Program. Staff reviewed with the group the festivities that will be taking place at the Count the Lights on the fire truck program to be held in Asti Park on December 6. The historic fire truck was relocated and positioned in the park by George Leo Kupfner on November 20. A motion was passed by members of the Commission to explore online fundraising opportunities to help with the fire truck restoration.
3. Discussion – Museum Window Shades. Mary Cartwright informed the group that custom window shades for the Museum have been ordered at JCPenney and will soon be delivered to the PROS office. Staff will assist in coordinating installation of the shades. A motion was passed by members of the Commission to begin to utilize existing funds in the old US Bank account, now HISTORICAL COMMISSION account (10-250-500) to cover approximately \$340 of the cost of the shades.
4. Discussion – Bednar & Bonelli Family Memorial Swing Bench. When weather permits Town staff will work to install the swing-bench in Asti Park. A mock-up of the memorial plaque language was passed around for the group to see. Stephen Bednar's name was added to the plaque language to appear alongside Laurel Russell and Louise Bennett recognizing them as donors of the swing-bench.
5. Discussion – December 6 Museum Opening. The Commission agreed to cancel their regularly scheduled Museum opening hours from 10 a.m to 2 p.m on

- December 6 and will instead be present that evening to staff the Museum for the Count the Lights holiday program. Those in the group who plan to attend that evening will be arriving at Asti Park at 4 p.m.
6. Discussion – Annual Holiday Potluck. Karen Waligorski announced to the group that due to an upcoming surgery she and Errol Waligorski will be cancelling this year's annual potluck that is typically held at their home.
  7. Discussion – Spring Education Program. A discussion was held on potential topics and/or speakers for the 2015 Spring Education program. Mary Cartwright suggested to the group that Commission Chair Larry Dorsey consider himself as a viable option for next year's program. Larry has presented in the past and expressed his appreciation for the suggestion.
