A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL BROADBAND SERVICES AT THE TOWN'S REGULAR ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to submit a ballot question to the registered electors of the Town at the November 8, 2016 regular election.

Section 1. At the Town's November 8, 2016 regular election, which election shall be coordinated with Boulder County, the following question shall be submitted to the registered electors of the Town:

BALLOT TEXT:


