Agenda Items:

1. Debriefing
 - a. The Museum saw a few visitors during the August 20 opening and forty visitors during the September 3 opening and ice cream social. The new Museum exhibit and social were both well received.
2. Discussion – Historic Fire Truck. Staff is awaiting a response from Mile High Classics owner Noah Stevens in regards to entering the truck in the November 25 Rocky Mountain Auto Show in Denver.
3. Discussion – Second Grade Field Trips. Dates have been finalized for the annual 2nd Grade field trips to Grasso Park, the Museum and Town Hall.

4. Discussion – 2016 Capital Improvement Projects. Staff will contact Colorado Seamless Gutters to proceed with installation of gutters around the perimeter of the house in Grasso Park and the Museum. Existing funds in the HISTORICAL MUSEUM AND GRASSO PARK IMPROVEMENT account (42-426-6535) will be used to cover the cost of this expense
5. Discussion – Museum Displays. “The Exceptional Miss Oerman & The History of Superior’s Schools” exhibit will continue through the month of October. Commission members will introduce a new “military” theme exhibit for the November and December openings.
6. Discussion – Cemetery Tour. The group has set a tentative date of October 22 for hosting its annual Tombstone Tour at the Cemetery. Commission Chair Larry Dorsey will contact Town staff regarding the group’s questions and concerns on accessibility to the Cemetery.
