

Tips for Building a Float

Combine a Team

It's a good idea to have teams doing specific tasks to spread the workload. Get a 1) Trailer Team, 2) Creative Design Team and 3) Construction Team. Because this isn't a project that comes along very often, involve as many people as possible. Ask your close by neighbors or gather a group of friends from other towns or neighborhoods to help.

Appoint a Head

Someone's got to be the bottom line. There has to be a coordinated effort for the group. When things don't go according to plan, and that will happen, then someone has to be able to make a decision about what to do next.

Enjoy the Experience

It's hard when you haven't done something before and don't know how it's going to turn out or even if it's going to turn out, but try to remember to have fun along the way. By nature, parade floats are about fun and celebration. It should be that way through the whole process.

With a big group, you're likely to have a wide range of interest and skill levels. To make it look good and like everyone worked together keep a 1) limited color palette, 2) repetitive shapes, and 3) easy to accomplish tasks.

These are some useful parade float building materials and tools although there are others and often the most successful parade floats are created from materials meant for the trash, recycled items and everyday household materials.

Glue Gun
Chicken coop wire fencing
Foam sheets
Scissors, knife, wire cutters and staplers/staple gun
Newspaper
Fabric
Paint
Glitter
Crepe Paper
Wood
Newspaper

You can be creative and use materials which have been recycled to build your parade float as well as any interesting and colorful arts and crafts materials you find in your local stores.
