Agenda Items:

1. Updates:

- a. Meadowlark/Coal Creek Regional Trail Signage – Boulder County staff are reviewing options for signage along the entire trail corridor, and may change and update the size and style. Town staff will redeploy the signs that directed trail users through Original Town to the Coal Creek Trail as an interim measure to direct citizens to the newly completed connection.
  - b. Trail Mapping – the Committee continues to look at this topic and consider establishing a subcommittee. John Nibarger volunteered to contact Boulder County staff regarding potential options for partnering.
  - c. Advisory Committee Chairs & Board Liaisons Meeting Follow-up – the Town Board will resume dialogue on this topic during their January 9 meeting.
  - d. Boulder County Parks and Open Space Advisory Committee – John Nibarger reviewed how POSAC participated in the Boulder County Commissioners' public hearing last week regarding croplands on open space. The meeting lasted several hours and included a significant amount of testimony from a wide range of perspectives on this issue. The Commissioners are expected to make a decision at a meeting later this month.
2. Discussion – 2012 Work Plan. The Committee reviewed and updated this year's Plan with potential items for 2012. The Committee members will receive the updated draft via email, and then plan to finalize during the January meeting.
3. Discussion – Parcels of Land Not Included in the Open Space Summary Report and Recommendations Document. As a follow-up item from the joint Town Board/OSAC meeting earlier this year, the Committee reviewed and discussed several properties not included in the original work to complete the Report.
