Agenda Items:

1. Discussion – Recommendations for 2012 Budget. The Committee prioritized its recommendations for new trail connections included in the 5-Year Trails Plan, and considered whether resources from the Open Space (OS) Fund should be applied to each. The results:
 - a. Coalton Trailhead to Highway 128 across Verhey Property; recommended for use of OS funding.
 - b. Adjacent to McCaslin from Christenson south to Coalton Trailhead; not recommended for OS funding.
 - c. Adjacent to McCaslin north from South Indiana to Fire Station Park; not recommended for OS funding.
 - d. Eldorado K-8 connections east of South Indiana to neighborhood access points; not recommended for OS funding.
 - e. 3rd Avenue trailhead/Meadowlark Trail connection from railbed east to McCaslin then north to Coal Creek Regional Trail; recommended for OS funding.
 - f. Formalize trails along southern portions Anderson/Weinstein parcels (not currently Town property) to 88th; not recommended for OS funding.
 - g. Shamrock Drive east of 88th for wildlife viewing at Hodgson Harris Reservoir; not recommended for OS funding.
 - h. West side of Sagamore neighborhood south and west to Singletree Trail; not recommended for OS funding.
