Regulations

- Unauthorized motor vehicles prohibited.
- Pets must be on a leash and under physical control at all times.
- Pick up your animal's waste and dispose of properly.



- > Stay on designated trail; private property borders trail in places.
- Bicyclists must yield the right-of-way to other users.
- Do not litter.
- Do not disturb natural vegetation or harass wildlife.
- Horses only allowed on portions of the Rock Creek Trail. Contact Boulder County Parks and Open Space for locations allowed.
- > Local ordinances apply.
