DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACE FOR THE POSTING OF MEETING  
NOTICES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Open Meetings Law and specifically C.R.S. § 24-6-402(2)(c), the Board of Commissioners must, at the first meeting of each year, designate a public place where notices of meetings will be posted.


NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SUPERIOR URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All notices of meetings of the Board of Commissioners shall be posted in the glass case attached to the outside wall of the building adjacent to the front entrance of the Superior Town Hall at 124 East Coal Creek Drive, Superior, Colorado. The Superior Town Clerk shall be responsible for posting the required notices no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting. All meeting notices shall include specific agenda information, where possible.
