



**PROCLAMATION  
SOCK IT TO EM**

**WHEREAS**, the Sock It To Em sock campaign was begun in Denver in 2011 and has spread to cities throughout the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, socks are the number one clothing need of the homeless, as they wear out faster than any other article of clothing, and are rarely donated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sock It To Em sock campaign has designated the second Wednesday in December as Sock It To Em Workday, a day when our residents are asked to forego wearing their socks as a show of support for the homeless, and to recognize the great need of homeless persons for warm socks; and

**WHEREAS**, as of April 2019, over 525,000 socks have been collected; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Superior fully and strongly supports this effort and encourages our residents to participate by going to work sockless and donating socks for the homeless.
