## TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-15 SERIES 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

WHEREAS, the Town has received revenues or has unappropriated fund balances for the Capital Improvement and Open Space Funds which were not anticipated at the time the budget for 2019 was initially adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Town must adopt supplemental appropriations for of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The supplemental budget for the Town of Superior for 2019 is \$26,736,706, as noted below:

Section 2. For the Town of Superior for the year 2019, the above sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated.

Section 3. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one, or part, or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 4. Safety. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
