AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 6 OF THE SUPERIOR MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 6-2-110, TO REMOVE THE DISTANCE RESTRICTIONS FROM SCHOOLS FOR ALL CLASSES OF LIQUOR LICENSES

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Article II of Chapter 6 of the Superior Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following new Section 6-2-110:

Sec. 6-2-110. Distance restrictions eliminated.

The 500-foot distance restrictions from schools, colleges, universities or seminaries, as set forth in C.R.S. § 44-3-313, as amended, are hereby eliminated for all classes of liquor licenses in the Town. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Board of Trustees shall, in any case where a proposed license is located within the prescribed distance restrictions of C.R.S. § 44-3-313, make a specific finding as to the impact of granting the license on said school, college, university or seminary, and may deny said license where said impact is not compatible with the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood or the desires of the adult inhabitants thereof.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}$. $\underline{\text{Safety}}$. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
