A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT ALONG ROCK CREEK CIRCLE FROM 30 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR

WHEREAS, Rock Creek Circle was built in the late 1990s as a collector street with a posted speed of 30 miles per hour;

WHEREAS, in May 2019, the Superior Public Works & Utilities Department conducted a traffic survey of Rock Creek Circle to determine the impacts of the current posted speed limit and whether a reduction in speed limit on Rock Creek Circle is warranted;

WHEREAS, the survey considered the road characteristics, current and future development, environmental factors, parking practices, pedestrian and bicycle activity in the vicinity, and crash statistics; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has reviewed the survey and finds it in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to reduce the maximum speed limit from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour on Rock Creek Circle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby reduces the speed limit along Rock Creek Circle from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour.


Section 2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 42-4-1102(2), the change in speed limit contemplated herein will be effective when appropriate signs giving notice of this change are erected upon the impacted portions of Rock Creek Circle.
