## TOWN OF SUPERIOR RESOLUTION NO. R-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, Mayor Clint Folsom declared a disaster emergency in and for the Town of Superior, Colorado, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. § 24-33.5-701, et seq. (the "Act");

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Board of Trustees extended the declaration for 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the emergency conditions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, as defined by C.R.S. § 24-33.5-702, persist and require additional and sustained action by the Town.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Mayor Folsom's declaration of a disaster emergency in and for the Town of Superior is hereby extended until rescinded by further action of the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), this Order shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Town Clerk, the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder, the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder and the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
