## **Ticket Holder Terms and Agreement:**

By purchasing these tickets, all guests agree to adhere to Boulder County Health Department requirements for drive-in events, including but not limited to the following list. In order to provide the safest and best drive-in concert experience, we require each participant to observe the following rules:

- 1. If you are sick, running a fever or have been exposed to COVID-19, please stay home until you are healthy.
- 2. Guests are required to wear a face covering when the car windows are open or when outside the vehicle.
- 3. We ask that restrooms be used for emergencies only during the show, and if used, guests must maintain social distancing.
- 4. No tailgating allowed, e.g., no barbeques, lawn chairs, blankets, no sitting in truck bed, no recreational activities such as frisbee or throwing balls.
- 5. Wondering/loitering of any kind is not allowed. We ask you leave your space ONLY to use the restroom or to get your concessions.
- 6. Socializing is not allowed between cars/bicycle spaces, you must stay with your own group to minimize contact.
- 7. Socializing is not permitted through open vehicle windows.
- 8. We encourage carpooling in one car with people in your immediate quarantine circle.
- 9. Guests are required to remain in their vehicles' or in their vehicles' immediate vicinity at all times with the exception of using the restroom or picking up concessions.
- 10. All participants must obey rules of the road.
- 11. All staff and participants/patrons must follow basic social distancing and use masks.
