## TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-14 SERIES 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR TO AMEND SECTION 2-2-20 REGARDING VACANCIES TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend the Code to provide that vacancies only need to be filled if there is at least six (6) months left in the vacant office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 2-2-20 of the Superior Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

## Sec. 2-2-20. - Vacancies.

If any elective officer of the Town becomes, during their his or her term of office, a nonresident of the Town, they he or she shall be deemed to vacate their his or her office. If any vacancy occurs in any elective office by death, resignation, removal or otherwise, and such vacant office has more than one hundred eighty (180) days left in its term, the same shall be filled by appointment by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees, and such appointee shall hold their his or her office only until the next general municipal election, when such vacancy shall be filled by election as in other cases.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Safety</u>. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
