A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE TO FUND A TRAILS MASTER PLAN FOR THE CENTURYLINK PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Town has applied for a \$25,000 grant from Colorado Parks and Wildlife to fund a trails master plan for the newly-acquired 182-acre CenturyLink property (the "Grant Application");

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees supports the Grant Application, and if the Grant Application is approved, the Board of Trustees supports the completion of the project;

WHEREAS, the Town intends to own the CenturyLink property for at least the next 25 years; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the Board of Trustees understands that the Town will need to contribute 30% matching funds, in the amount of \$7,500, which funds will be expended from the Town's 2021 Open Space Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Board of Trustees hereby approves the submission of the Grant Application to Colorado Parks and Wildlife, and authorizes Town staff to execute any documents necessary for the submission of the Grant Application.
