## TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-2 SERIES 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AMENDING SECTION 7-3-20 OF THE SUPERIOR MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE AGE TO ENTER A CIGAR-TOBACCO BAR

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7-3-20(b) of the Superior Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

## Sec. 7-3-20. General smoking restrictions.

\* \* \*

(b) A cigar-tobacco bar shall not expand its size or change its location from the size and location in which it existed at the time this Article was enacted. A cigar-tobacco bar shall display signage in at least one (1) conspicuous place and at least four (4) inches by six (6) inches in size, stating:

## "SMOKING ALLOWED, PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS OF AGE MAY NOT ENTER."

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Safety.</u> This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
