**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
SUPERIOR APPROVING THE TOWN'S PARTICIPATION IN COLORADO
COMMUNITIES FOR CLIMATE ACTION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recognizes the significant impacts to our community and many others that are already taking place, and the likelihood that these impacts will continue to intensify in the coming years, including additional infrastructure costs, health impacts to community members, economic impacts to businesses, water supply and water quality challenges, and others;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees accepted a Vision Statement for Environmental Sustainability to achieve climate action goals related to greenhouse gas emission reduction, energy conservation, waste reduction, water conservation and air quality;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recognizes that local policies and local action, while critical, will not alone be sufficient to meet our own climate, energy, and sustainability goals, nor will they alone be sufficient to reduce the severity of climate change and its impacts to our community;

WHEREAS, Colorado Communities for Climate Action ("CC4CA") was established to further the adoption of federal and state policies that will: a) strengthen statewide and federal policies impacting greenhouse gas emissions in Colorado; and b) provide local governments in Colorado with the tools, funding, flexibility, and authority necessary to adopt effective climate protection strategies; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to have an effective voice in the development of statewide energy and greenhouse gas reduction policies.
