## TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-7 SERIES 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AMENDING SECTION 2-6-20 OF THE SUPERIOR MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A TOWN OFFICIAL SERVE ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to remove the requirement that a Town official serve on the Planning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 2-6-20 of the Superior Municipal Code are hereby amended as follows:

## Sec. 2-6-20 — Members; terms; removals; vacancies.

- (a) Members. The Planning Commission shall be comprised of nine (9) at large members, consisting of one (1) appointed official of the Town and eight (8) at large members appointed by the Mayor with approval of the Board of Trustees.
- (b) Term. The term of the Town Clerk or other administrative official shall correspond to their term of tenure with the Town. The terms of the eight (8) at large members shall be four (4) years or until the member's successor takes office. Terms shall be staggered.

- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that anyone or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
- <u>Section 3</u>. <u>Safety</u>. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
