**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SUPERIOR  
URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY ADOPTING A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING  
SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE SUPERIOR URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY FOR  
2022**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the Superior Urban Renewal Authority ("SURA") must adopt an annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, C.R.S. § 29-1-101, *et seq.*;

**WHEREAS**, a proposed 2022 SURA Budget was submitted to the Board on August 30, 2021 for the Board's consideration;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at the Superior Town Hall, 124 E. Coal Creek Drive, Superior, Colorado;

**WHEREAS**, the Board held a properly-noticed public hearing on November 8, 2021 and interested persons were given the opportunity to register any objections to the 2022 SURA Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the 2022 SURA Budget to and for the purposes described below, so as not to impair the operations of SURA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SUPERIOR URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY:**

**Section 1.** The following are estimated expenditures for the Superior Urban Renewal Authority for 2022:

Downtown Superior Property Tax	<u>4,242,500</u>
Total	<u>\$4,242,500</u>

**Section 2.** The 2022 SURA Budget, as submitted to the Board, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the Superior Urban Renewal Authority for 2022.

**Section 3.** For the Superior Urban Renewal Authority for 2022, the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated:
