A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF A FINAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR STC, PHASE 10 FOR CENTRAL, SUPERIOR TOWN CENTER, CASE NO. FDP-1

WHEREAS, the Town (the "Applicant") wishes to develop certain property located within the Town, generally described as Tract D of Superior Town Center (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Applicant has filed an application for a final development plan (the "FDP") to improve the Property with Central Park, one of five parks planned for the subdivision (the "Application");

WHEREAS, Section 16-10-40 of the Code requires a public hearing and recommendation by the Planning Commission on the FDP;

WHEREAS, the specific approval criteria for the FDP are set forth in Section 16-10-40(b) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the Planning Commission held a properly-noticed public hearing on the Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Planning Commission hereby finds that the Application meets all applicable requirements of the Code.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Planning Commission hereby recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the FDP subject to the following conditions:
- A. Before final documents are signed and recorded, Applicant shall make minor technical and redline corrections to plans as identified by Town staff;
- B. Prior to consideration by the Board of Trustees, Applicant shall modify its plans, per the recommendation of the Planning Commission, to replace the surface area in the dog parks with grass and not gravel as previously suggested; and
