Q&A

When and where is this year's Chili & Beer Fest?

Community Park, 1350 Coalton Road, Superior from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Where can I park for the event?

We encourage everyone to walk or ride their bike to the event. A FREE Bike Check station will be available. If you need to drive, parking will be available at the northeast corner of McCaslin Blvd. and Coalton Rd. offering a FREE shuttle to Community Park. The shuttle bus will run from 1:30 to 7:00 p.m. making a round trip every 15 minutes.

How much does the event cost?

There is no cost for general admission which includes chili samples from the Community cook-off and People's Choice cook-off (while supplies last). Anyone 21 years of age and older may purchase a **Beer Fest ticket** (\$35) online prior to the event or at the event box office the day-of. Cash and cards accepted.

VIP tickets are also available for purchase (\$65) online in advance or at the box office day of. A VIP ticket gets you the full Chili & Beer Fest experience with the comforts of a private tent, additional food, beer, wine and cider options. Hosted by Serendipity Tap & Café.

Single-serve beer and seltzers will also be available for purchase (cash or card) from the Rotary's Beer Garden booth for anyone 21 years of age and older. ID will be required and a wristband must be obtained before being served.

Tickets can be purchased online until 1:55 p.m. on Saturday and then will be available for purchase at the event box office outside of the gate. Day of ticket prices will increase by \$5.

Will there be any other food options other than chili?

Yes, a number of food trucks will be on-site offering various food and drink items for purchase.

Will there be any kids' activities at the event?

Yes, a super-sized kids zone will be available including bouncy castles, free face painting, an obstacle course, and a magician and balloon artist.



Can I bring my dog to the event?

Yes, but to be sure everyone has a great time there are a few rules to keep everyone safe and happy:

- Well-behaved dogs are welcome on a non-retractable leash at all times or at a locked 6' maximum lead
- Please avoid bringing dogs into the food areas (chili cook-off, food trucks, eating areas)
- Please bring your own water for your pet
- Please bring waste bags and clean up after your pet.
- Dogs must be current on rabies vaccination
- The Town of Superior event organizer reserves the right to eject any aggressive, or obviously ill animals
- Pet owners assume full responsibility for their pets
