Pursuant to C.R.S. § 1-13.5-513(1), the Board of Directors hereby cancels the May 3, 2022 regular election of the Superior/McCaslin Interchange Metropolitan District, finding that, at the close of business on March 1, 2022, there were not more candidates for director than offices to be filled, including candidates filing affidavits of intent to be write-in candidates.
