TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-15 SERIES 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE SUPERIOR MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXEMPT CERTAIN BUSINESSES FROM LOCAL BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 22-032 eliminated fees for local business licenses for certain businesses without a physical presence or with only an incidental physical presence in the local taxing jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend its business license application process to comply with Senate Bill 22-032.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 6 of the Superior Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 6-1-110, to read as follows:

Sec. 6-1-110. – **Exemptions.**

This Chapter shall not apply to the following entities:

- (a) Nonprofit corporations or businesses, excluding federal, state and municipal corporations;
- (b) Businesses without a physical presence in the Town; and
- (c) Businesses with only an incidental physical presence in the Town.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3. Safety. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
