






FIRE-STOPPING GABLE VENT


Dryer vents should auto-close when the dryer is off


THE ROLE OF NATIVE GRASSLANDS

Healthy native grasses also help with fire mitigation by preventing drier and bulkier weeds from growing in our open spaces.






