Estimated Wildlife Incidents Resulting in Deaths and Injuries (United States, Annual)

- An estimated 365-988 million birds are killed due to building/window collisions
- An estimated 2.4 billion birds are killed by domestic cats (contiguous United States only).
- Between 6.3 and 22.3 billion mammals are killed by domestic cats and dogs (contiguous United States only).
- Injuries from dog and cat attacks result in 14% of cases brought into wildlife rehabilitation centers. Although this percentage seems small, such attacks are the second most common known cause for wildlife injury.
- The number one reason for being brought into a rehabilitation center is due to being orphaned (25% of cases).
- Motor vehicle strikes kill more than one million vertebrates *every day*.
- *Four hundred million animals are killed by motor vehicles annually.*
