The Long Strike in the Northern Colorado Coal Fields from 1910 to 1914 resulted in frustration, desperation, and strained relationships. These three ingredients, stirred in the cauldron of the strike, boiled over in the shooting death of John “Dude” Searcy at the Superior Depot on November 28, 1911 and the Superior town marshal being put on trial for Searcy’s murder.
