## TOWN OF SUPERIOR ORDINANCE NO. 0-3 SERIES 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AMENDING ARTICLE XXXI OF CHAPTER 16 OF THE SUPERIOR MUNICIPAL CODE, TO REGULATE THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES LOCATED ON TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY AND WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1.</u> Article XXXI of Chapter 16 of the Superior Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following new Section 16-31-90:

Sec. 16-31-90. Town-owned property and public rights-of-way.

Any telecommunications facility located on Town-owned property or within any public right-of-way shall not exceed forty (40) feet in height.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3. Safety. This Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.
