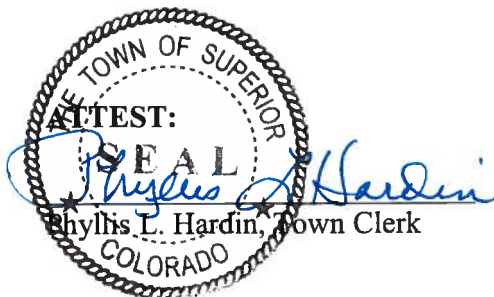
**WHEREAS**, the Town of Superior recognizes that if we work together, hunger and homelessness are solvable; and
